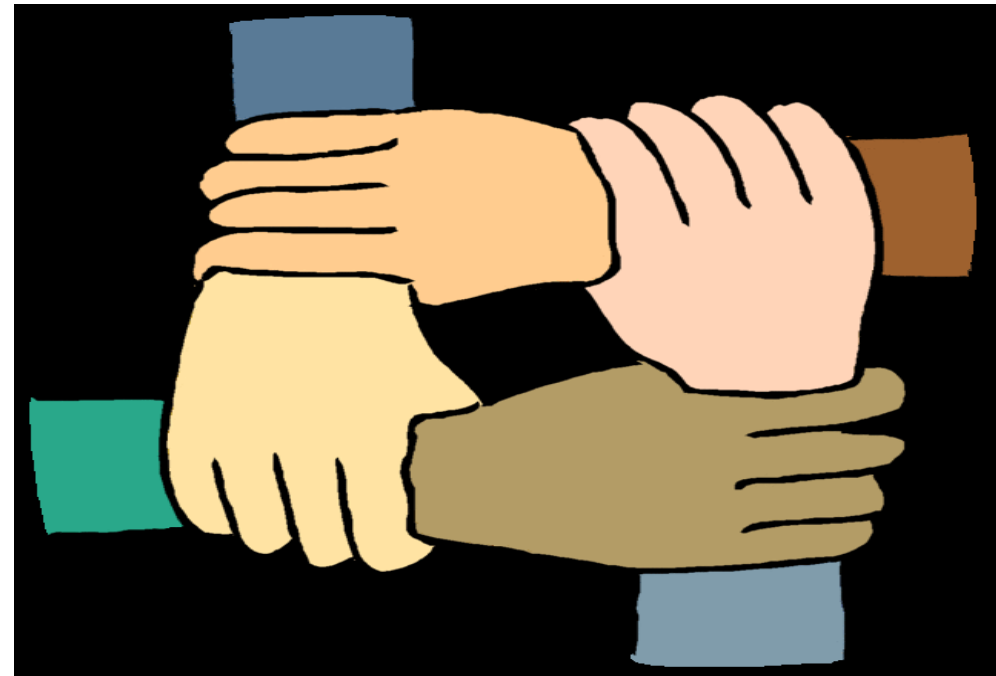

ORGANIZATION OVERVIEW

San Romanoway Revitalization Association (SRRA) is a non-profit social services organization founded on the premise of Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design and Crime Prevention Through Social Development. Our Mission Statement is: To create a sense of belonging in the San Romanoway community by assisting families, individuals and groups to support each other by building a safer and healthier environment.

The Achievers Project is a partnership between the San Romanoway Revitalization Association, the Toronto District School Board and the National Crime Prevention Centre. It is a three-year initiative offered at Brookview and Elia Middle Schools for students 11 to 14 years of age. This innovative project has several components which provide positive alternatives to youth school dropout, antisocial behaviour, drugs, criminal activity and gang involvement.

Youth 'N' Charge is a youth led, youth driven project of the SRRA in its third year of operation. YNC provides youth with counseling, entrepreneurship training, job skills workshops, resume writing assistance, talent and music production skills in a fully equipped recording studio.
